Wounded, Ill and Injured service members are encouraged to learn more about TRICARE and Medicare benefits to avoid a lapse in coverage.

Regardless of age, if you have a disability and you're receiving Social Security disability payments, you will become eligible for Medicare Part A (premium-free) and Part B (with a monthly premium) beginning the 25th month of receiving Social Security disability payments.

Under Federal law, if you're a TRICARE beneficiary eligible for premium-free Medicare Part A, you MUST have Medicare Part B coverage to remain TRICAREeligible.
