WHAT CAN CLINICAL PHARMACY DO FOR YOU?

- **Medication Education:** Answer any medication related questions that you may have & ensure proper medication use.
- **Medication Review:** Explain the purpose of your medications and improve medication therapy outcomes.
- **Combine medications and possibly reduce unnecessary medication use.**
- **Medication Safety Monitoring:** Screening for medication interactions and possible side effects.
- **Discuss and review treatment and goals.**
- **Offer 30 and 60 minute appointment times to discuss medication concerns in depth.**
